## PLANTING TIPS FOR AMERICAN BEACHGRASS

(Ammophila breviligulata)

## Plant Culms 12 to 24 inches Apart

(Depending on location on dune)

## 1. OPEN BOX IMMEDIATELY UPON DELIVERY.

- 2. Plant as soon as possible for best survival.
- 3. Stand plants up as soon as box is opened (if not planting immediately).
- 4. Cut top string on plant bundle.
- 5. Day after receiving plants Dip plant roots in 2 inches of water (10 minutes or less). Do not leave plants in water.
- 6. Remove plants and put back in box standing up on roots.
- 7. Keep plants in cool place.
- 8. Plant plants 6 to 8 inches deep.
- 9. Space plants about 12 to 24 inches apart.
- 10. Use trowel, spade, or peg for planting. Soil should be firmly packed around roots (be careful not to cut plant roots or bend plant stem when planting).
- 11. If no rain within 4 to 5 days of planting, manual watering is recommended.
- 12. Fertilize plants lightly after planting (broadcast over the soil surface). Use 4 pounds of 16-4-8 per 1000 square feet. The use of a slow release Nitrogen fertilizer is beneficial to the environment.
